The Government of Namibia has received financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) towards the cost of the Institutional Strengthening for a Public-Private Partnerships Project (ISPPP), and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this Grant to payments under the contract for Development of Monitoring and Evaluation Framework.

The overall objective of the assignment is to:

- In line with the Namibia's Integrated National Performance Framework, develop a *full Monitoring and Evaluation Framework, which includes amongst others:* 
  - o tools for assessing of the impact of the procurement system on the socio economic policy objectives of the Government
  - o Tools for measuring performance of the public procurement system, and
- Capacitate PPU staff on the M&E framework

The Ministry of Finance now invites eligible Consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).

The Procurement Policy Unit is executing its mandate according to Section 6 & 7 of the Public Procurement Act of 2015 but requires an Individual Consultant to support the Procurement Policy Unit up to a period of nine (9) months
